

## Compilation of pupils' work DVD version

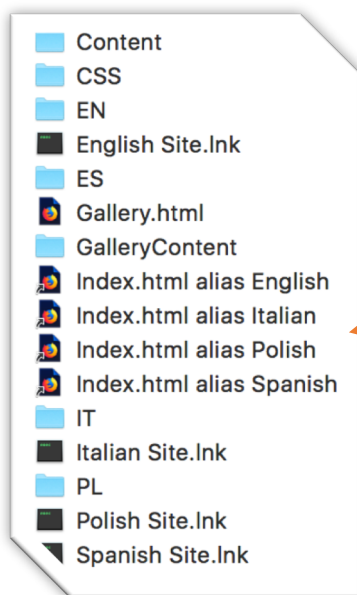

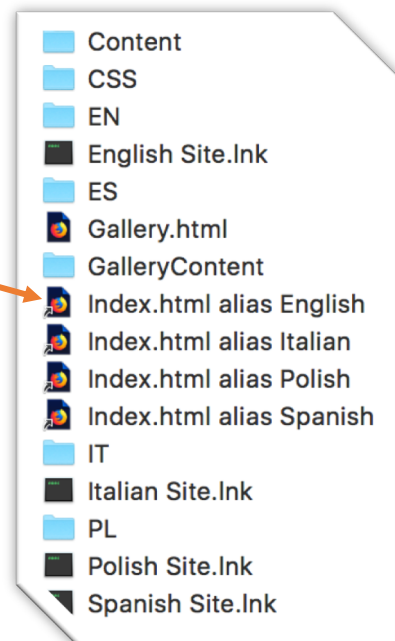
The folder may take a long time to download as it is a very large file.
